Information about McAfee Client Proxy 4.1.5 Hotfix 1 release

This hotfix resolves issues related to mutual authentication, traffic redirection issue when using ethernet and alternate proxy server polling interval.

Reference	Resolution
MCP-4496	Due to proxy polling issue, McAfee Client Proxy failed to reach proxy servers to redirect traffic. This issue is now resolved. (Windows only)
MCP-4528	McAfee Client Proxy stopped redirecting when WIFI was changed to ethernet. This issue is now resolved. (Windows only)
MCP-4658	McAfee Client Proxy auto policy download no longer fails on the secure channel after updating HA proxy on the Cloud proxies.
